

BERRIOS AND MARCUNE MEET IN 10 TONIGHT

New York, Jan. 1 [Special]— Miguel Berrios of Puerto Rico and Pat Marcune of New York, a pair of 130 pounders, will open the 1956 boxing season in St. Nicholas arena tomorrow night. Their 10 round bout will be seen in Chicago over WGN-TV, channel 9, at 9 p. m. Central Standard time.

Berrios has had only 17 pro fights and has won 12, lost 5, and scored one knockout. Marcune, a harder hitter with 16 KO's in 55 bouts, has a record of 35-17-3.
