

# Floyd Patterson Shifted; Now No. 5 In Heavy Ranks

NEW YORK — (INS) — Floyd Patterson, hitherto top challenger for Archie Moore's Light Heavyweight title, was listed as the fifth-ranking contender for Rocky Marciano's vacated Heavyweight crown by Ring magazine.

With Marciano retired, Patterson was shifted to the Heavyweight

division where he will fight it out in an elimination for the right to succeed Rocky.

Until the elimination series begins, Archie Moore rates no. 1, with Tommy (Hurricane) Jackson behind him. Then follow Bob Baker, John Holman, Patterson, Johnny Summerlin, Willie Pastrano,

Harold Carter, Bob Satterfield and Eddie Machen.

All hands moved up a peg in the Light Heavy division, Charles Colin of France returning to the no. 10 position, Gerhard Hecht of Germany heads the contenders with Yolande Pompey of Trinidad, second.

The defeat of Milo Savage by Charley Joseph and Gene Fullmer's victory over Ralph Jones brought a big shift to the Middleweight ratings. Charley Humez of France has been returned to no. 2 slot behind Bobo Olson.

Fullmer is third, Bobby Boyd fourth, Savage down three pegs fifth and Jones down two to seventh.

Cherif Hamia of France jumped all the way from eighth to third in the Featherweight rankings.
